



THE BACKGROUND

[Enviroquest GPT Ltd](#) is a chemical manufacturing company based in the United Kingdom.

They manufacture, package, supply and distribute a wide range of chemicals products. Our markets include timber preservation, home & garden, and pest control. Products are distributed in the United Kingdom, Republic of Ireland and into mainland Europe.

Their aim is to supply our markets with the safest, most efficacious products which comply with all Local, National, European, and Worldwide regulations.

THE CHALLENGE

With a range of Wood Preservatives, they were required to comply with the complexities of the EU BPR by way of submission of 2 product Dossiers to cover 4 formulations which were sold in numerous Member States. This was not an easy or straightforward task.
